## **SUMMARY:**

### **Research Capacities Database**

- Centres to review their centres information to ensure it is accurate and provide us with their updates.
- Also let us know the information that you would like to be kept private.

### **Regulations and Ethics Data**

- The database for regulations and ethics will need to be validated when available.
- The regulations and ethic report that was sent to the European Commission will be available on the website.
- The report showed lots of disparity between countries.
- There are also disparities even within countries.
- The role of the European Correspondent should include validating the data.
- The main contact point for each country for Regulations and Ethics should be included in the database.

### **Trial Register**

- It would be useful to have the current trials ongoing in the centres on our website, please provide us with the information.

- Also useful to have a link to the trial register.
- Nutrition trial register, is there a link that already exists? We need to increase visibility. WHO international trial register, look for agreement from the WHO, e.g. enforcement from Ethics committees.
- See [www.stroketrials.org](http://www.stroketrials.org), there is a lot of cross collaboration.
- There is a need for more detail in [clinicaltrials.gov](http://clinicaltrials.gov).
- We need a **TASK FORCE** for this topic, please let us know if you would like to **VOLUNTEER**.

### **Website**

- Include “Useful links” on the website
- Useful to have translated versions of questionnaires in the relevant local language, only on request.

### **SOPs**

- Please check the list of SOPs provided in the presentation and let us know if you would like to be the reference centre for the methods mentioned (English version, validated, gold standard), slide numbers 80,81

### **Certification**

- Mission of the certification process should be specific for nutrition, e.g. clinical investigation.
- GCP guidelines applied to clinical trials in nutrition, which guidelines apply in practise?
- The process for certifying the centres should be described.
- We need a **TASK FORCE** for this topic, please let us know if you would like to **VOLUNTEER**.

### **H2020**

- Standardised form for future calls to be developed.

- Marie Curie calls of interest, scientific relevance of the call important, INFORM could be utilised within Marie Curie calls if needed, replicate with other topics, several potential calls to apply to in 2015.
- ESPEN could also be involved within a broader scope, geriatrics, microbiology, consider relevant people to join the hub.
- Let us know urgently if you would like to work together on H2020 calls and also your topics of interest.
